## **RESOLUTION 10-08**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORMANDY, MISSOURI, UPHOLDING THE ORDINANCES PERTAINING TO DANGEROUS ANIMALS AND AUTHORIZING ALL CITY DEPARTMENTS TO ENFORCE SAID ORDINANCES WITHIN THE CITY OF NORMANDY.

WHEREAS, the City of Normandy recognizes that no community is immune from the hazards of dangerous animals and it is important to protect residents and businesses from threats posed by dangerous animals; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Normandy has determined Pit Bull terriers and Rottweilers to have inherently dangerous and vicious propensities, and potentially are hazardous and unreasonably dangerous to the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Normandy; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Normandy previously enacted ordinances to protect residents and businesses from dangerous animals, especially Pit Bulls and Rottweilers; and

WHEREAS, under Section 205.130 of the City Code, the City of Normandy has prohibited the registration of Pit Bulls (except those registered prior to 3/10/1998) and Rottweilers (except those registered prior to 12/05/2000) from being within the City limits; and

**WHEREAS**, under that system of registration, there are no registered Pit Bulls or Rottweilers registered within the City limits of Normandy; and

**WHEREAS**, it is not uncommon to see pit bulls and Rottweilers within the borders of the City of Normandy despite their non-registered status.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMANDY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One.

The City of Normandy acknowledges that all City officers, agencies and departments shall have the ability to enforce the ordinances as they pertain to dangerous animals to the fullest extent provided by law.
