AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE II, CHAPTER 240, OF THE CITY OF NORMANDY, MISSOURI, CODE PERTAINING TO THE CONSUMPTION OF FOOD AND BEVERAGES IN THE PARK

WHEREAS, the proliferation of improperly disposed of trash and other litter has become an increasing problem in the City of Normandy's parks; and

WHEREAS, the existence of improperly disposed of trash and other litter in the City's parks poses a risk to the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City, the wildlife and plant-life indigenous to the City and the environment in general; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMANDY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section One.</u> Chapter 240, Section 240.320, Personal Conduct in Parks, of the City of Normandy Municipal Code is hereby amended, by the addition of a new Subsection 8, to read as follows:

8. Except as otherwise permitted by this Chapter, enter such park having in his/her possession pre-packaged food and drink items including, but not limited to, candy, chips, bottled or canned beverages.

Section Two.

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that each and every part, section and subsection of this Ordinance shall be separate and severable from each and every other part, section and subsection hereof and that the City Council intends to adopt each said part, section and subsection separately and independently of any other part, section and subsection. In the event that any part of this Ordinance shall be determined to be or to have been unlawful or unconstitutional, the remaining parts, sections and subsections shall be and remain in full force and effect.

Section Three.

The Chapter, Article, Division and/or Section assignments designated in this Ordinance may be revised and altered in the process of recodifying or servicing the City's Code of Ordinances upon supplementation of such code if, in the discretion of the editor, an alternative designation would be more reasonable. In adjusting such designations the editor may also change other designations and numerical assignment of code sections to accommodate such changes.

Section Four.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
