## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE II, CHAPTER 235, OF THE CITY OF NORMANDY, MISSOURI, CODE PERTAINING TO THE SCREENING OF DUMPSTERS.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Normandy, Missouri, wishes to protect the health, safety and general welfare of the City's residents; and

WHEREAS, improperly screened and enclosed dumpsters allow vermin and other pests to scavenge through the refuse with greater ease; and

WHEREAS, improperly screened and enclosed dumpsters constitute an eyesore; and

## NOW, THERFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMANDY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

**Section One.** Chapter 235, is hereby amended by the addition of a new Section 235.065, entitled "Trash Containers – Screening", to read as follows:

- 1. All commercial buildings and buildings containing four or more residential units within the City of Normandy, having one or more trash containers shall adequately screen the trash containers with appropriate materials, so as to conceal the visibility of the trash containers from the right-of-way and from neighboring properties. For the purposes of this Section a "trash container" is any container that is over 100 gallons in size and which is not for public use.
- 2. All such trash container enclosures shall conform to all yard and setback requirements for principal and accessory structures. This ordinance shall not apply to any trash containers which are located in a rear yard, as defined in Section 405.020, within 20 (twenty) feet of the main structure.
- 3. Screening for trash containers shall be of a material that matches or is compatible with the building.

**Section Two.** It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that each and every part, section and subsection of this Ordinance shall be separate and severable from each and every other part, section and subsection hereof and that the City Council intends to adopt each said part, section and subsection separately and independently of any other part, section and subsection. In the event that any part of this Ordinance shall be determined to be or to have been unlawful or unconstitutional, the remaining parts, sections and subsections shall be and remain in full force and effect.

**Section Three.** The Chapter, Article, Division and/or Section assignments designated in this Ordinance may be revised and altered in the process of recodifying or servicing the City's Code of Ordinances upon supplementation of such code if, in the discretion of the editor, an alternative designation would be more reasonable. In adjusting such designations the editor may also change other designations and numerical assignment of code sections to accommodate such changes.
