The City of Normandy, St. Louis County, Missouri, is seeking proposals from qualified haulers to contract with the City for solid waste collection services. The City is furnishing herein a set of specifications by which such proposals shall be considered.

Sealed proposals shall be submitted no later than 2:00 pm on Monday, November 15, 2021, to:

Proposals shall be clearly marked on the envelope as "PROPOSAL FOR SOLID WASTE COLLECTION".

Haulers may submit question to the City in writing no later than 5 days before the due date. Any oral communication is considered unofficial and non-binding on the City. The City of Normandy reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, to waive any irregularities and/or informalities in any proposal, solicit new proposals, or further negotiate with the Contractor of its choice.

Bid Specification -

- Once per week curbside trash collection for all single-family residences that reside in the City of Normandy, Missouri. Trash is to be picked up in designated trash containers.
- Once per week curbside recycling collection for all residences that reside in the City of Normandy, Missouri. Recycling to be limited to designated recycling containers.
- Once per week dumpster service for (2) city dumpsters, (1) located at Normandy City Hall and (1) located at Normandy Public Works.
- Once per week courtesy service for (18) city-owned trash cans along Natural Bridge Road and (3) city-owned trash cans at Hoelzel Park.
- Once per week bulk item removal for each residence. Pickup limited to 2 items up to 150 lbs. Electronics and appliances are excluded.
- Once per week yard waste collection limited to 6 brown paper yard waste bags per residence, bags are to be provided by customer. Yard waste collection provided 12 months per year.
- Contractor is responsible for providing trash and recycling containers and replacing containers damaged in the course of performing collection services. Contractor may use, at contractor's discretion, existing City owned trash and recycling containers for the remainder of their useful life.
- Recycling and yard waste disposal cost shall be included in the bid.
- Hauler is responsible for billing and collection from residents directly.
- Hauler must include the proposed service day(s) for trash, recycle, yard waste, and bulk pickup with their bid.
- Hauler must submit a proposal security in the amount of \$10,000 with their bid.
- Hauler must include how they will accommodate servicing disabled residents with their bid.
- Hauler will start service no later than Monday, December 6, 2021.
- All bids must include the attached NON-COLLUSION AFFIDAVIT.
- Bids and eventual contract agreement will be for a term of 3 years.

The City reserves the right to determine the competence and financial and operational capacity of any Contractor. Upon request of the City, the Contractor shall furnish additional evidence as may be required by the City. The City shall be the sole and final judge of such competency, and its decision shall be final and not subject to recourse by any person, firm or corporation.

The public opening and reading of all proposals shall commence at 1:00 P.M. on Wednesday, November 17, 2021, at Normandy City Hall, 7700 Natural Bridge Rd., Normandy, MO 63121, where all bids will be publicly opened and read out loud.
