**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE III, CHAPTER 355,
OF THE CITY OF NORMANDY, MISSOURI, CODE BY
ADDING A NEW SECTION PROHIBITING THE
PARKING OF A VEHICLE FOR OVER ONE WEEK ON A
PUBLIC STREET**

WHEREAS, it has become increasingly common to observe vehicles parked or left standing on public streets for unreasonably long periods of time; and

WHEREAS, the proliferation of vehicles parked or left standing on public streets for unreasonably long periods of time impedes both the flow of traffic and the provision of Municipal services such as snow removal; and

**THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF NORMANDY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section One. Chapter 355 is hereby amended by the addition of a new Section 355.110 which shall read as follows:

TITLE III

TRAFFIC CODE

CHAPTER 355

**STOPPING, STANDING, OR PARKING
PROHIBITED**

SECTION 355.110

**PARKING OVER ONE WEEK
PROHIBITED**

No person shall park or leave standing or cause to be parked or left standing any vehicle upon any public street in the City continuously for a period of one (1) week or longer.

Section Two.

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that each and every part, section and subsection of this Ordinance shall be separate and severable from each and every other part, section and subsection hereof and that the City Council intends to adopt each said part, section and subsection separately and independently of any other part, section and subsection. In the event that any part of this

Ordinance shall be determined to be or to have been unlawful or unconstitutional, the remaining parts, sections and subsections shall be and remain in full force and effect.

Section Three.

The Chapter, Article, Division and/or Section assignments designated in this Ordinance may be revised and altered in the process of recodifying or servicing the City's Code of Ordinances upon supplementation of such code if, in the discretion of the editor, an alternative designation would be more reasonable. In adjusting such designations the editor may also change other designations and numerical assignment of code sections to accommodate such changes.

Section Four.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
