**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE II, CHAPTER 215,
OF THE CITY OF NORMANDY, MISSOURI, CODE
PERTAINING TO A CURFEW FOR MINORS UNDER 17
YEARS OF AGE.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
NORMANDY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section One. Chapter 215, Section 215.780, Curfew for Minors under Seventeen-Imposed-Prohibitions and Restrictions, of the City of Normandy Municipal Code is hereby amended, as follows: (Additions shown as **bold and underline**; deletions shown as ~~strikeout~~)

It shall be unlawful for any minor under the age of seventeen (17) years to loiter, idle, wander, stroll or to drive or ride in an automobile, or play in or upon the public streets, parks, playgrounds or other public grounds, public places and public buildings, places of amusement and entertainment, vacant lots or other unsupervised places, between the hours of ~~11:00 P.M.~~ **9.00 P.M.** and 6:00 A.M. of the following day, official City time, except on Fridays and Saturdays, when the hours shall be ~~12:00 Midnight~~ **11.00 P.M.** to 6:00 A.M. of the following day, official City time; provided, that the provisions of this Section do not apply to a minor accompanied by his/her parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor, or where the minor is upon an emergency errand or legitimate business directed by his/her parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor. Each violation of the provisions of this Section shall constitute a separate offense.

Section Two. Chapter 215, Section 215.790, Curfew-Responsibility of Parents, Guardians etc., for Violations by Minors, of the City of Normandy Municipal Code is hereby amended, as follows: (Additions shown as **bold and underline**; deletions shown as ~~strikeout~~)

It shall be unlawful for the parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of a minor under the age of seventeen (17) years to knowingly permit such minor to loiter, idle, wander, stroll or to drive or ride in an

automobile, or play in or upon the public streets, parks, playgrounds, wharves, docks or other public grounds, public places and public buildings, places of amusement and entertainment, vacant lots or other unsupervised places, between the hours of ~~11:00 P.M.~~ **9.00 P.M.** and 6:00 A.M. of the following day, official City time, except on Fridays and Saturdays when the hours shall be ~~12:00 Midnight~~ **11.00 P.M.** to 6:00 A.M. of the following day, official City time; provided, that the provisions of this Section do not apply when the minor is accompanied by his/her parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor, or where the minor is upon an emergency errand or legitimate business directed by his/her parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor. Each violation of the provisions of this Section shall constitute a separate offense.

Section Three.

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that each and every part, section and subsection of this Ordinance shall be separate and severable from each and every other part, section and subsection hereof and that the City Council intends to adopt each said part, section and subsection separately and independently of any other part, section and subsection. In the event that any part of this Ordinance shall be determined to be or to have been unlawful or unconstitutional, the remaining parts, sections and subsections shall be and remain in full force and effect.

Section Four.

The Chapter, Article, Division and/or Section assignments designated in this Ordinance may be revised and altered in the process of recodifying or servicing the City's Code of Ordinances upon supplementation of such code if, in the discretion of the editor, an alternative designation would be more reasonable. In adjusting such designations the editor may also change other designations and numerical assignment of code sections to accommodate such changes.

Section Five.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
