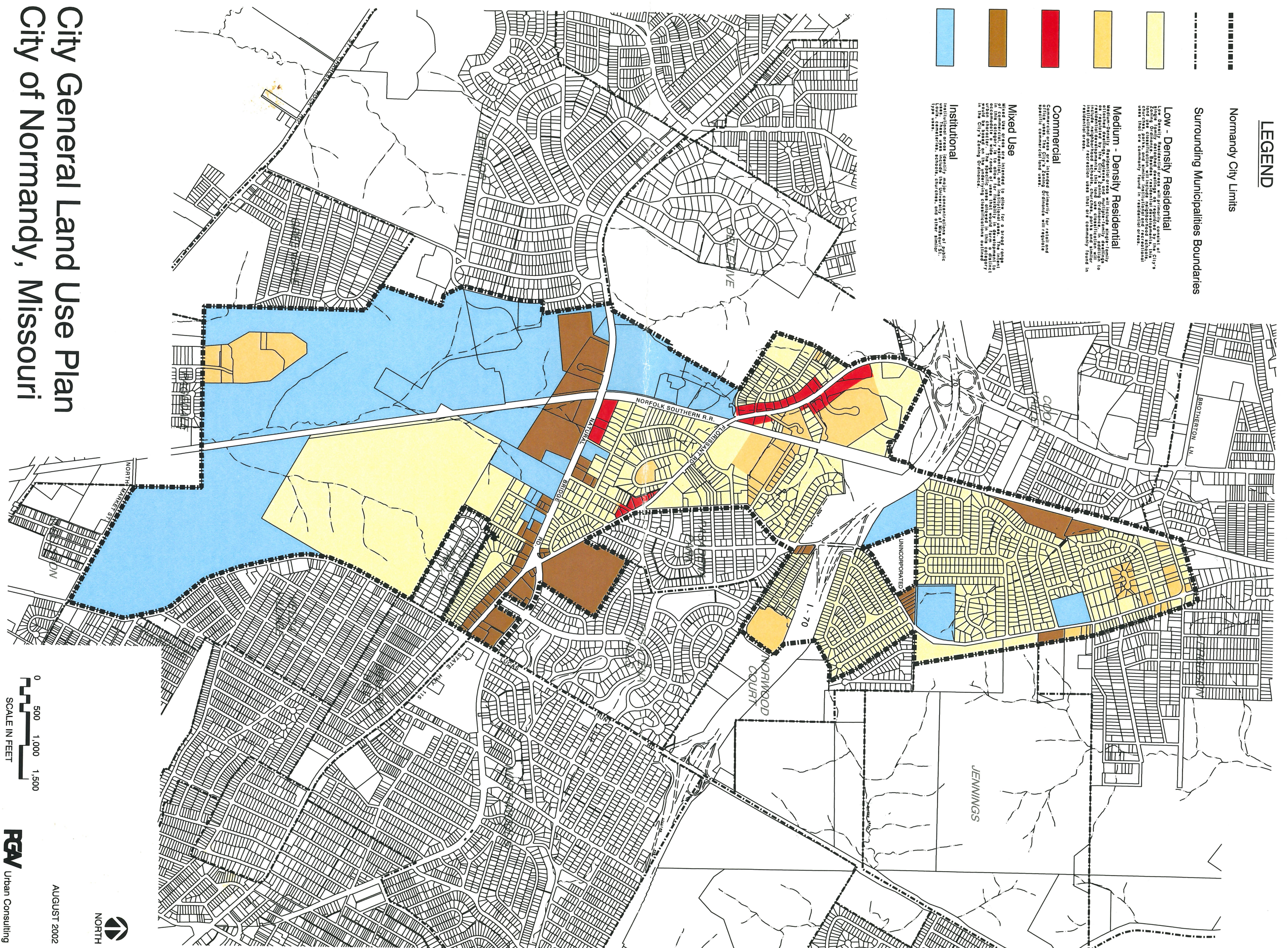
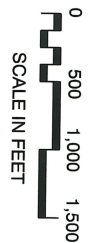

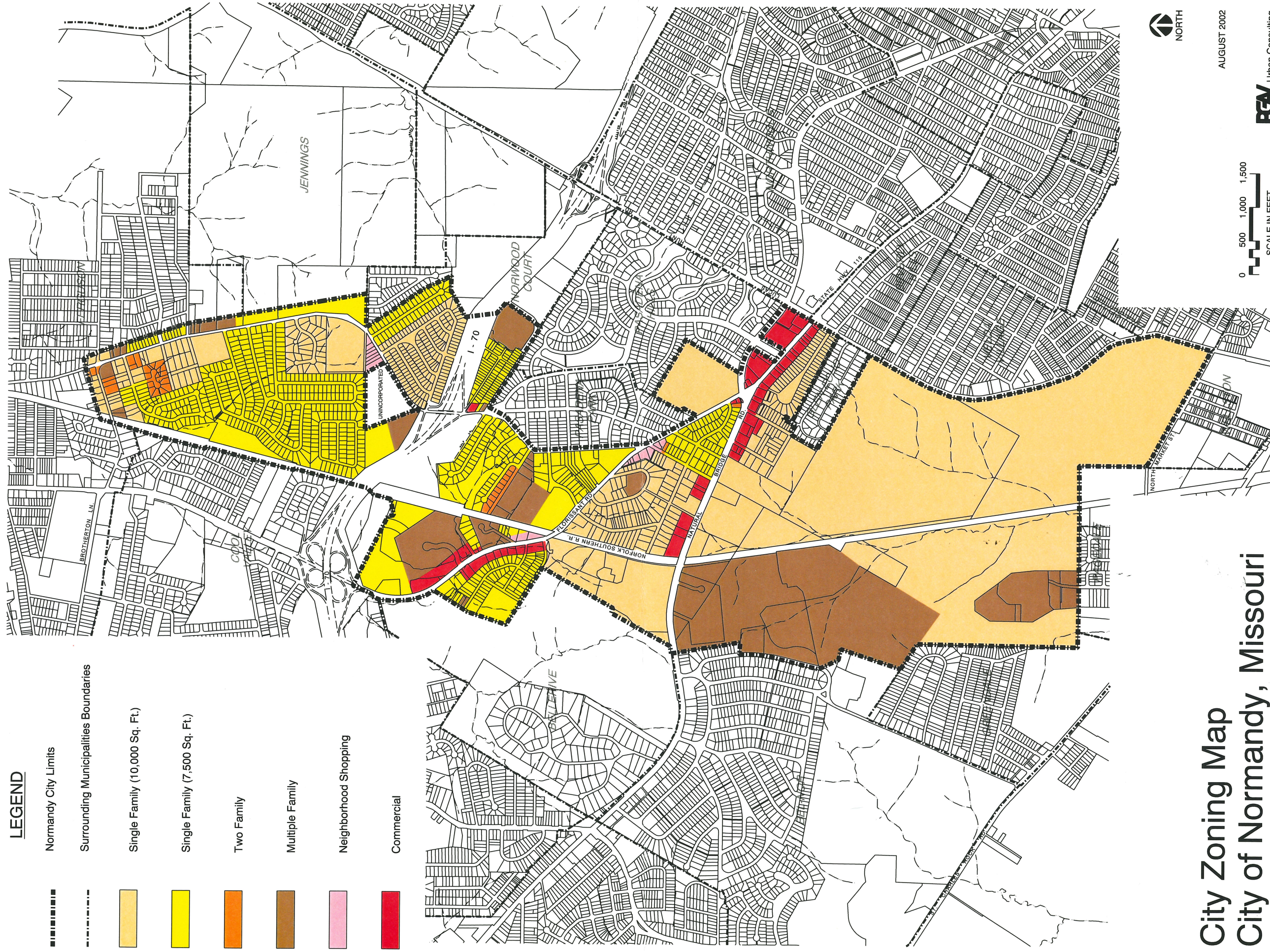

 - Commercial**
Commercial uses are intended to serve the needs of the community. Commercial uses include retail, service, and other uses that are primarily used for commercial purposes. This use is commonly found in commercial areas that are commonly found in commercial areas.
 - Mixed Use**
Mixed use areas are intended to serve the needs of the community. Mixed use areas include residential, commercial, and other uses that are primarily used for mixed use purposes. This use is commonly found in mixed use areas that are commonly found in mixed use areas.
 - Institutional**
Institutional uses are intended to serve the needs of the community. Institutional uses include educational, cultural, and other uses that are primarily used for institutional purposes. This use is commonly found in institutional areas that are commonly found in institutional areas.
